You can contribute via check, credit card, electronic funds transfer, or stock. We also encourage you to explore matching gift opportunities with your employer.


Gifts to the campaign are tax deductible as a charitable contribution to the full extent of the law.

WHY NOW?

Since the construction of our original campus, almost 100 years ago, building codes and safety standards have changed.

The City of San Francisco recently required an evaluation of all private schools to make sure every school in the city is in compliance with modern building codes.

When we received our results, we recognized that we needed to strengthen our school building through a seismic retrofitting project. In consultation with the Archdiocese of San Francisco Building Department, we have formulated a comprehensive plan and hired professional firms to undertake the planning and construction of the project.

As a result, these improvements will make St. Monica's one of the safest schools in the City.

OUR GOALS

In addition to the seismic retrofitting, we will undertake a series of voluntary improvement projects that will make St. Monica's a safer, more accessible place. These will include projects like installing a new fire alarm and new external doors outfitted with security systems.

We will also build a modern Science Lab (see mock-up below) that will further St. Monica's reputation for providing quality educational programs.





OUR PLAN

The *Building Our Legacy for the Next Century* campaign seeks to raise a minimum of \$1.25 million in gifts and pledges, above and beyond weekly giving. All of the money raised from this campaign will be directly invested to fund this special project.

Construction will begin during the summer of 2017 and be completed for the beginning of the school year 2017-2018.

Campaign Plan Elements

Total Campaign Goal \$1,250,000

Seismic Retrofitting

- Secure the roof structure to the perimeter walls:
- Embellish the roof diaphragm strength; and,
- Confirm the adequacy of the strength of the perimeter shear walls.

Additional Improvements

- Install a new Fire Alarm System;
- Update accessibility to public spaces in a good faith effort to meet City planning requirements;
- Modify and/or replace all external doors and add new security systems;
- Renovate a classroom to become a modern Science Lab; and,
- Provide funds for deferred maintenance of the church building, such as painting the exterior.
